1. Requirement for attendance concession for students appearing for professional exams: The attendance requirement as per Mumbai University has to be compulsorily met by all students. Some attendance concession is given for students appearing for professional exams.
2. Provide practical learning along with theories: Faculties are asked to provide more practical based examples.
3. Provide good environment in class to study effortlessly along with new efficient technology: Specious classrooms are provided with AC and Wi-Fi facilities.
4. More practical knowledge to be included in the syllabus which will enrich the development of the student: This is already part of the syllabus under NEP.
5. Syllabus is in line with industry requirement: Efforts will be taken to maintain the same.
6. More internship opportunities needed: More internship opportunities will be provided to the students for career exploration, development and to learn new skills under NEP.
7. Case studies should be given to learn from market: Faculties are asked to provide more Case Studies based on real time scenario.
