Career Development Cell

Career Development Cell had 46 students registered this year. In August, CDC hosted the corporate festival Udaan 2016. This three day corporate festival, saw people from the corporate world interact with students on various topics.

On 2nd August 2016, a certified trainer, Mr. D'costa conducted a workshop on 'Team Building' through activities in which students learnt the art of building and working in a team. On 3rd August 2016, Mr. Satish Bendre, a Corporate Trainer/Consultant spoke upon 'Discover Yourself where the students were trained to identify and fight barriers which stop them from being successful. On 4th August 2016, CDC witnessed SEED Infotech conduct an aptitude test for the Banking and Insurance students. Lipika Jain (T.Y.B.A.F.), Nehal Poojary, Kajal Balas (T.Y.B.B.I.) Harsh Shah (F.Y.B.B.I.) scored the highest and have been selected by SEED and will be given the training to crack banking exams for free.

Career Development Cell welcomed Angel Broking on our campus on 23rd September 2016. Currently 3 students are interning with them and are receiving training in market analysis and share broking techniques. Seed Infotech conducted sessions for the B.Sc.IT /CS students in cracking an aptitude test and were trained in interview skills as well. All this equipped our students so well that out of the 18 who attended the interview with Infosys, 8 have been selected to join this illustrious company from May 2017.

SEED Infotech also conducted similar workshops in December for our Banking & Insurance, Accounting and Finance, Financial Markets and Management students customising the learning module to suit their needs.

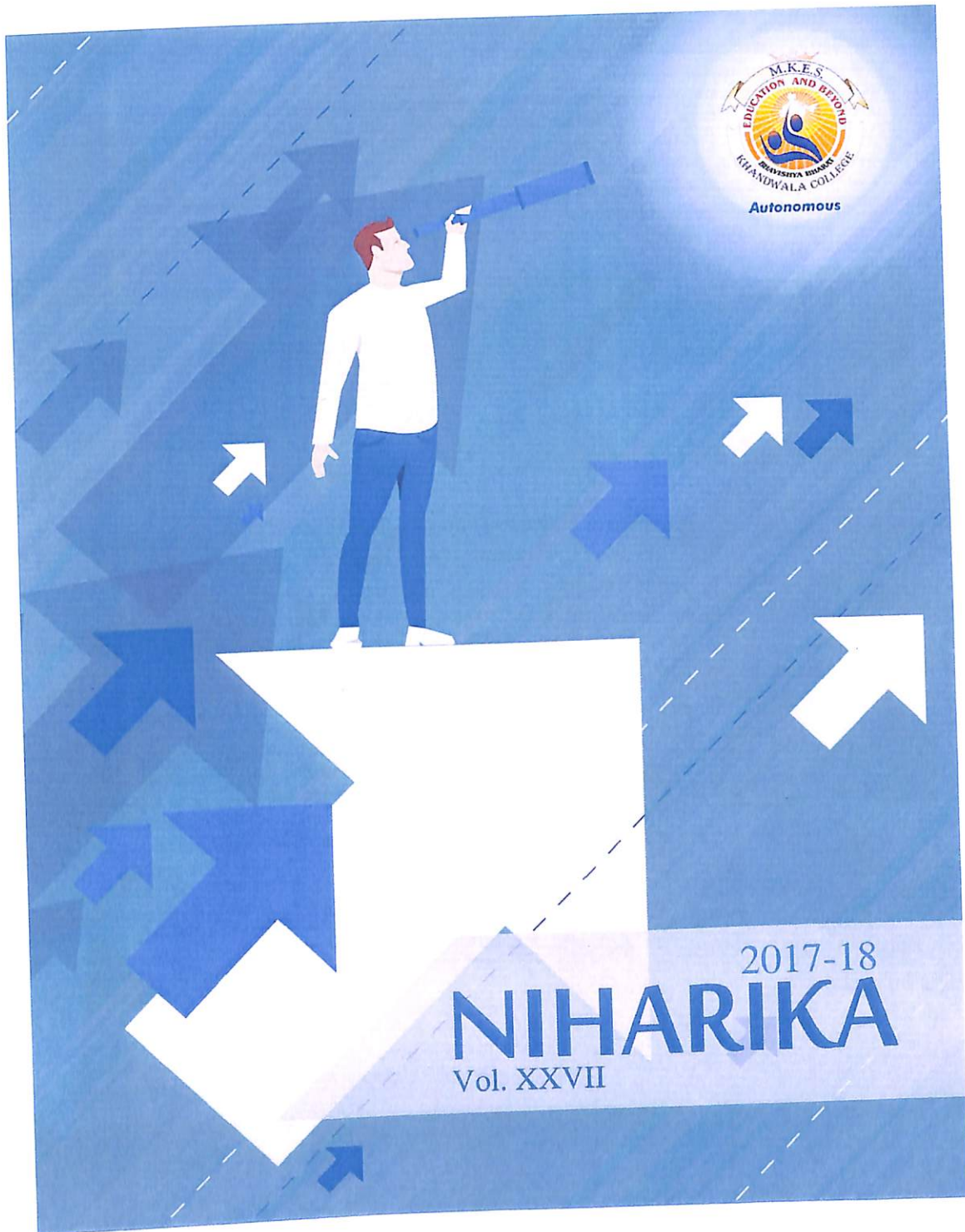

Career Development and Placement Cell

The year 2017-18 began on a numerical high for the Career Development Cell. 420 students registered with us out of which 145 were from the Commerce section, both Aided and Self Finance sections and 275 are from the BSc. CS/IT .These include the First,second and the third year students.

CDC believes in the importance of 'We' over the 'I'. So our very first event was on Team Building on the 28th of June, conducted by Ms Shobha Venketesh , the former GM, Vertex Securities Ltd. Participants learnt the value of a team through very interactive management games that kept everyone including the faculty members on their toes.

Increasing suicide rates amongst young people and growing stress levels were addressed at the Pranic healing workshop conducted on the 24th July 2017. Mr. Monish Shah led the participants to experience the positive and negative aspects of the surrounding energy. A ten minute meditation technique was the best take away from this session that when practised everyday leaves a sense of peace and well being in the mind of the practioner. Around 63 students benefited from this session.

Experiential learning is the mantra of today. And CDC wishes to give a platform for a hands on learning. On the 25th of July 2017, 85 students joined our resource person, Purv Shah to learn about financial markets, both bullish and bearish at Mock Stock. In a

The third floor of the Self Finance building provided an opportunity for the CDC and the Department of Mass Media to collaborate. Dustbins have been provided for each of the four classrooms on the floor besides a huge one for the entire floor. We thus demonstrated our continued support to the Swachh Bharat Campaign.



CDC celebrated its three day corporate fest "UDAAN" from the 27th to 29th July. Ms. Lavina Utamani of the Art of Living was the resource person for all the three days. Ms. Lavina Utamani, a Bio Medical Engineer, and formally a Senior Product Designer for a tech start up - Smart Logic. Inc is currently attached to the Art of Living programme. Students were trained at the Art of Resume Writing to suit the job applied for. A practical session in group discussion was hugely popular with the students. The Do's and Dont's during a personal interview with live demonstrations benefited the participants much. Each student participant received a Certificate from The Art of Living. Mr. Chintan Bhatia, an alumnus of the 2005 batch, a Commander with Air India and currently Secretary of the Khandwala Alumni Association was the chief guest on the 29th July 2017, the concluding day of UDAAN. He felicitated the new office bearers of CDC ably led by Student Chairpersons Mitali Vora of BMS and Aditya Majumdar of BFM. CDC also warmly welcomed the new faculty members who have been contributing immensely to CDC-Asst. Prof. Ninoshka D'Silva and Asst. Prof. Ashish Modi.



In August 2017, Big Bazaar offered our students a live

project. 5 First year students of the Department of Management Studies and from the Department of Accounting Finance grabbed the opportunity to interact with customers on the floor of Big Bazaar, Malad and Goregaon. This was for a 5 day period from 12th to 16th August on a 9 hour shift. Students got the opportunity to interface with customers understand their needs and offer customer satisfaction. They were also exposed to the logistic challenges of a Retail Store.

On 15th September 2017, representatives of IIMUN-Indian International Model United Nations visited our campus to offer internships in Celebrity Management, Finance Sales and Event Management. Out of the 85 who participated, 9 students were selected for the 3 month internship from 10th November 2017 to 10th February 2018.

Never to rest too long as soon as the college re-opened in November 2017, CDC organized a workshop for the First year students on 18th November 2017. Mr. Jigar Desai, Senior Executive, All Cargo Logistics one of Asia's largest logistics firms and a Management Studies alumnus took the students in a two session capsule through the nuances of Group Discussion through live demonstrations. 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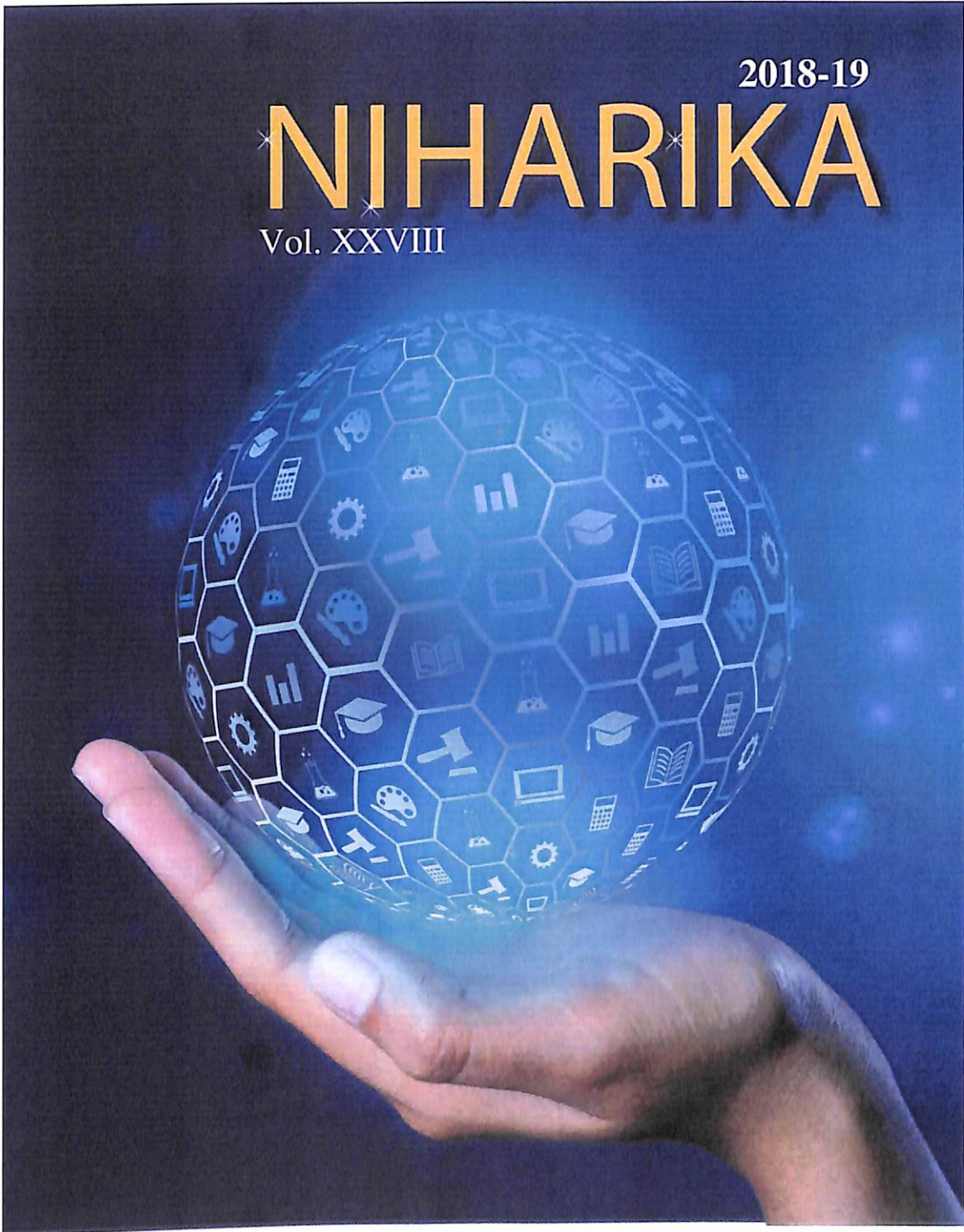
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Academic Year 2018-19

The Career Development Cell began its registration for the academic year 2018-19 from the first week of June. We are happy to report that 101 students from the CS/IT departments, 61 students from Commerce registered with us for soft skills training and for guidance in achieving their career goals.

On 16th July 2018, Ms. Namita Agarwal of Career Santa addressed our Third year students on career opportunities and growth in various industrial sectors. This was followed by an aptitude test for the commerce section on 26th July 2018, administered by Edu Research. Students were tested on quantitative ability and error detection, general aptitude and logical reasoning. Each student received their scores to their personal email account. CDC takes its corporate social responsibility seriously. We participated in Mr. Dadarao Bhilore's initiative in filling potholes on JVLR, Seepz on 29th July 2018. Mr. Bhilore lost his son tragically to the poor Mumbai roads and has made it his life's mission to fill potholes in Mumbai so that the tragedy that hit his family is not experienced in another home.

Rushabh Shah, Student Chairperson of CDC conducted a very interactive team building exercise on 5th August 2018 for the student executives. Peppered with games and fun, the initiative met its goal of strengthening the CDC team spirit. The investiture ceremony for the new team was held on 8th August 2018, where students and staff received their badges and blazers. He spoke on "Live simple. Live well." For over two and a half hours Mr. Raval kept the auditorium in splits. His humour and simplicity had us all floored.

CDC is happy to put on record that 6 of our IT/CS students have already received job offers. These students along with their parents were felicitated by Mr. Sanjay Raval at Udaan. On 29th August 2018, registered students were trained in Personal Interviews and Resume writing by industry experts from the aviation industry.

On 1st September 2018, Career Development Cell addressed the M.Com students encouraging all of them to enrol. 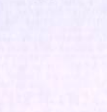

Career Development Cell started its innings this year with its flagship corporate fest Udaan which as always, focuses on enhancing the soft skills of students to make them future-ready.

We were delighted to have Mr. B. S. Nagesh, Chairman of Shoppers Stop and Founder of TRRAIN- the Trust for Retailers and Retail Associates, addressed our student delegates.

We also had Mr. Maneesh Jha, director of SQUAD Infotech Pvt. Ltd who motivated our students to make them corporate ready. SQUAD Infotech Pvt. Ltd. ('SQUAD') is Mumbai's first dedicated Professional Training Center for Software Testing. SQUAD conducts career oriented, Professional Training-cum-Placement programs on Software Testing, imparting training to fresh graduates and offers them placements in various IT companies.

CDC made history by signing the Memorandum of Understanding with, both these eminent companies.

Our 23 BAF, Computer Science and IT female students are being trained by TRRAINHer Ascent for the retail industry. This will be followed by placements and the squad has agreed to impart soft skills training to our registered students.

We also had the Group Discussion session that was spearheaded by the Squad Team.



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Mr. Rohit Sharma and Mr. Ashwin Sonawane gave practical exposure and insights on how to crack the group discussion stage of the interview process.

Udaan with the same spirit continued with Personal Interview and Resume Writing sessions. This session was again led by the Squad Infotech team.

On 26th September 2019 we signed an MoU with Expectrons, An AI-based company. Expectrons will be connecting our registered students via video conferencing with young industry captains. These industry representatives will be mentoring our students on how to crack interviews in their companies with their own experiences.

We are happy that Dr. Chaubey and CA Sindhu Menon representing the aided section have come on board. To equip students with tools for time, stress and conflict management Mr. Satish Bendre conducted a very interactive games session with the registered students on 13th December 2019.

On 7th January 2020 Squad Infotech executed a campus assessment program to shortlist candidates for career opportunities in IT firms. On 27th February 2020, Career Development Cell held a Career Fair, 'Campus to Corporate'.

On the college campus which was powered by Frapp, Over 35 companies, from all over India, were hosted by the Career Development Cell. More than 350 students participated from all over Mumbai and above 900



interviews were conducted. The Career Fair was a huge success and benefited not only the students but also the companies. In such competitive times, when getting internships or jobs are extremely difficult, Career Development Cell provided an opportunity to the students to get quality internships and jobs; and to the companies to get quality students to fill their vacancies. Unfortunately, due to Covid-19, the offers to the shortlisted candidates are yet to be made.

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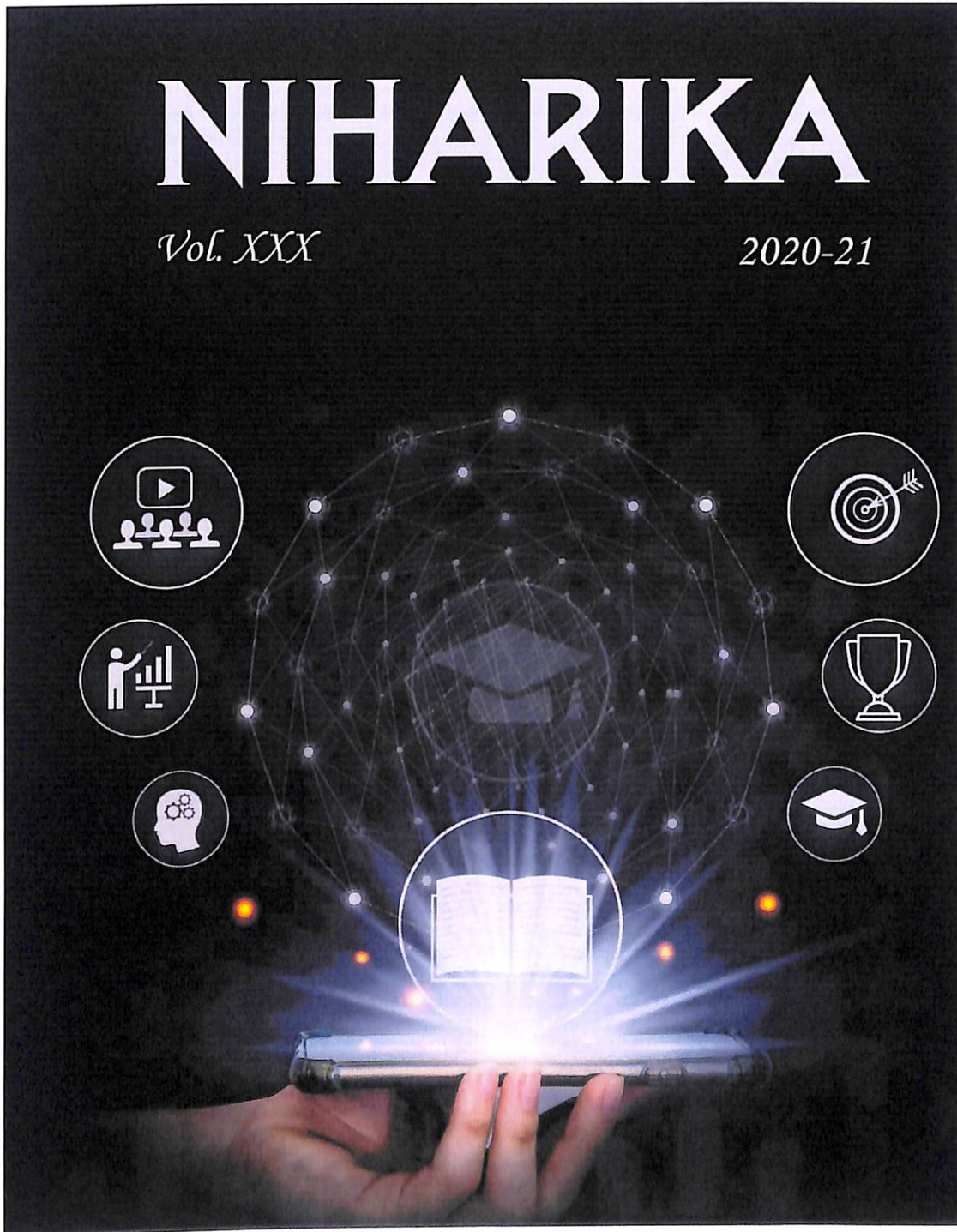

On 8th February 2021, Mr. Ankur Singh, Manager Financial Literacy & Outreach- Digital Payments, RBI addressed 30 students



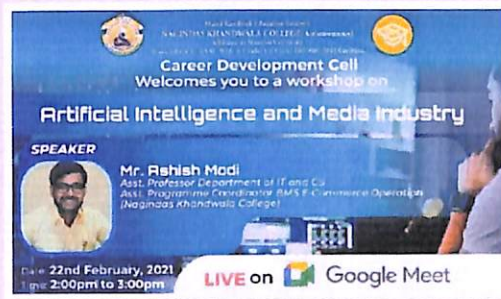
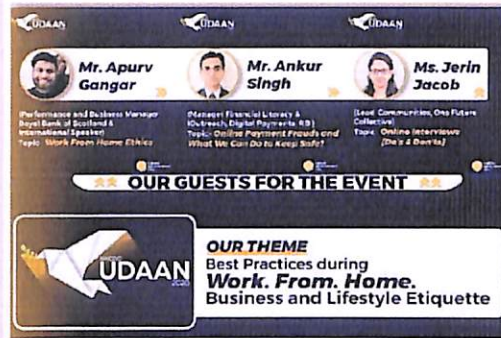
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on 'Identification of Financial Cyber Fraud- How can they be Prevented or Resolved'.
