Supported by the Management of the Malad Khandwala Education Society, the Department of English organised a National Seminar on the Use of Technology in Language Learning and Teaching on 11th September 2018. Renowned journalist and author, Ms. Nandita C. Puri was the Chief Guest.



for the Inauguration of the Seminar. Ms. Vijaylaxmi Koppikar read the Keynote Address since the Keynote Speaker, Professor Emeritus Dr. S. Mohanraj, former faculty from English and Foreign Languages University (EFLU), Hyderabad, was unable to make it to the Seminar. Dr. P. Selvam from Coimbatore University was the Resource Person for the first technical session. He traced the development of the use of technology in language teaching and the current scenario for the same in India.

The next Technical Session was conducted by Dr. Kishema Jose from EFLU, who spoke about the latest trends in the use of technology in language learning and teaching in India and discussed the possibilities that the future could bring. This was followed by paper presentations.

The Seminar was attended by about 60 delegates. The event ended with a Valedictory Ceremony which was graced by the Chief Guest, Dr. Vasumathi Badrinathan, HOD of the Department of French at the University of Mumbai. She gave a talk titled, "Technology and Language Learning in India - Where Does the Path Lead for Tomorrow?" The delegates expressed satisfaction with the seminar and expressed their willingness to attend similar programmes in future.

The seven research papers received from faculty across the country were subsequently published in the November 2018 issue of a UGC recognised journal carrying an ISSN, called Research Chronicles.



### International Accounting Conference

The Accountancy Department of Nagindas Khandwala College organized the International Accounting Conference on 26th November 2016. The keynote speaker for the session, Dr. Pratibha Bhat, Senior Prof. & Chairperson - MBA (Law), NMIMS School of Business Management spoke on the topic 'Strategic Risk Management in Emerging Business Ecosystem'. The session was peppered with lots of stories, anecdotes and real-life instances. Post lunch, a workshop by Leap up Academy was arranged on 'Value at Risk- A better way to look at Portfolio risk'.

The participants were given hands-on experience in the computer lab about calculation of Value at Risk for stocks of companies, using excel spreadsheets. The second technical session began after the workshop and was chaired by CA Dr. Renu Datta and CA Dr. Rupal Shah. Mr. Gaurang Trivedi, Senior Consultant - Finance & Management was the keynote speaker for the session who spoke on the topic 'Risk Management in Banking Sector'. ## INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

*The Internal Quality Assurance Cell plays a vital role in maintaining and enhancing the quality of any institution. This year, in order to tackle the various challenges faced by educators during the lockdown, the IQAC of Nagindas Khandwala College organized various programmes and training initiatives to help the faculty maintain a healthy balance between their personal and professional lives.*

On 21st and 22nd May 2020, the IQAC organized a Faculty Development Program on 'Beginners Kit for Online Teaching Tools'. This programme was conducted via Zoom. The teachers were able to familiarise themselves with various tools and platforms available to make online learning an engaging experience.

While this programme was appreciated by all the participants, IQAC also wanted to address the psychological and emotional aspects of living and working in this unprecedented scenario. Hence, from 4th to 7th June 2021, a four day Faculty Development Programme was organized. The theme was 'Managing Difficult Times'. On the first day, Mr. Sasikumar, Director at Centre of Development of Advanced

Computing (CDAC), gave a talk on 'Managing Teaching Online in Difficult Times'. The next day, Mr. Shardul Purohit, Blogger and Psychology Enthusiast, addressed the challenge of 'Managing Communication in Difficult Times'. The third day saw Mr. Harshit Adukia, Senior Manager of Talent Management from VVF Group sharing his thoughts on 'Compassionate Leadership'. On the final day, Mr. Kush Bohra, Founder of ZENrich Life gave the participants useful suggestions to pursue 'Conscious Growth'.

On 11th June 2020, a National level Webinar on "Stress Management among Teachers: Through Wisdom of Srimad Bhagavad Geeta" was organized. The speaker was Shri. Baldev Das, the Director of the Youth Link of ISKCON. Participants from all across India participated in large numbers and drew the benefit of the timeless wisdom of Indian spirituality.

GRAND JURY INDIA HIGHER EDUCATION RANKINGS 2021-22

Seetharamu**, former professor of education at the Institute of Social and Economic Change (ISEC), Bangalore was constituted.
