

Report on Degree Certificate Distribution Ceremony – 29th April 2026

The Degree Certificate Distribution Ceremony for the students who had graduated in Academic Year 2024-2025 was held on 29th April 2026. The Chief Guest of the ceremony was Mr. Dishant Nisar, All India Rank 19, UPSC Civil Series Examination 2025, and Alumnus of Nagindas Khandwala College. The function was attended by 523 students from 10 programmes.
