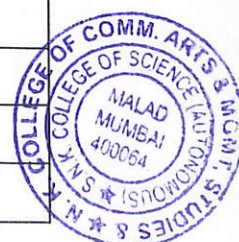

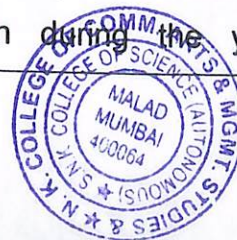

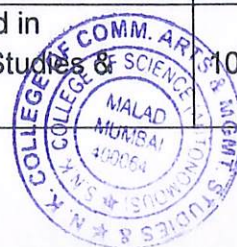


## Working of IQAC


