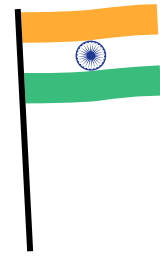

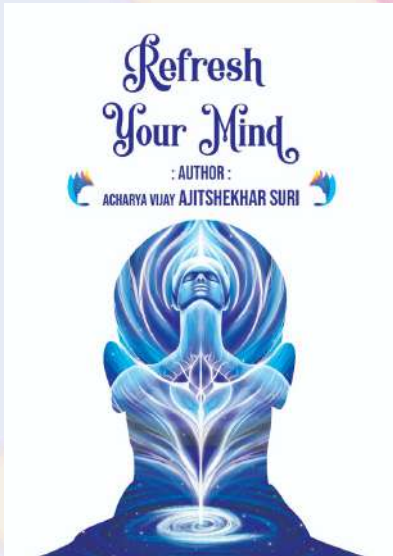

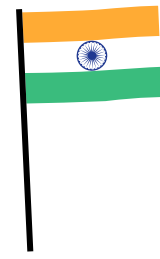


**YOUTH WITH VISION**

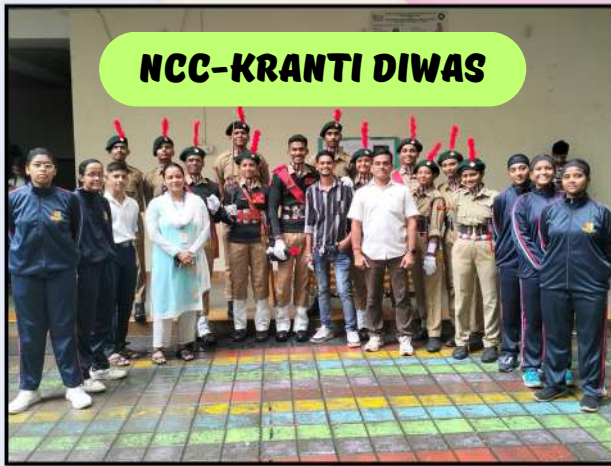






**FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS**
