Description

The "Positive Male Role Models" essay writing competition, organized by the Rotaract Club of Khandwala, aimed to celebrate and recognize the valuable contributions of men in shaping society. As part of the groundwork, the Editorials and Digital Communication Department worked collaboratively to plan and execute the event—setting up the registration process, designing clear submission guidelines, and creating an online drive for collecting entries. Participants were invited to reflect on and write about influential male figures in their lives or communities, with many also submitting geotagged photos to add a creative dimension. The event provided a meaningful platform for thoughtful expression, encouraging students to acknowledge and appreciate the positive impact of men in various roles. Awarded 2 hours of co-curricular credit, the event aligned with the NEP's emphasis on holistic development through reflective, value-based activities. Feedback revealed that participants found the task insightful and engaging, with the added photo element enhancing creativity. Overall, the initiative left a lasting impression, successfully highlighting the importance of positive male role models and fostering gratitude for their influence.






